



Participation Requirements

General

The participation in the international multimedia competition on "Sustainable Lifestyles and Climate Protection requires the following entry rules.

Out of organisational reasons, all participants have to apply online following the links on www.klimaclima.org

Please note that we will need to receive the following data from every participant:

Name, Date of Birth, Address, E-Mail address, Telephone number

Participation requirements

Young adults until the age of 30 are permitted to participate. You can apply as a single person or as a group.

Each piece of work has to be handed in by 11.59 PM on Sunday, the 21st of February, 2010.

Each person / each group is allowed to hand in only one internet film or one photo story in *one* of the promoting countries Germany, Greece, Italy or Latvia. The internet films and photo stories should deal with the current issues of competition.

Members of all European countries are welcome to participate in the competition, though the submissions have to be in German, Greek, Italian, Latvian language, or subtitled in English.

Participants of the competition who are not resident in one of the countries mentioned above and hand in their work in English can choose in which one of the four countries, but only one of them, they hand in their works. Participants of the competition who are not resident in one of the countries mentioned above and hand in their work in one of the allowed languages have to apply in the respective country.

Formats and technical requirements for turning in the contributions

We are looking for your contributions in either one of the following formats of multimedia competition which are tackling the issue of Climate change, everyday life and lifestyles. Your submission must not be older than two years.

Internet film

Lifestyle, everyday and climate change can be dealt with in a maximum of 5 minutes of any video format (short film, documentary, infotainment, video spot, ...). Participants are asked to take into consideration recent lifestyle and media references, as well as to bring in a personal perspective and a creative approaches.

Contributions must be submitted as .avi, .mpeg4, .flw, or .3gp. If you have produced a different file format, please make sure to convert it into one of the above. Please do not send us video DVDs. Please do not upload files which are larger than 300MB.

Internet films can be directly uploaded on the secure uploading site of the organiser. In addition to that it is possible to send the films via regular mail on a CD/DVD.

Photo Story

An inspiring perspective of the topic with a maximum of six fotos and maximum of 150 characters of descriptive text.

Contributions must be submitted as .psd, .pdd, .jpeg, .gif, .bmp, .pdf, .tif or .tiff. If you



have produced a different file format, please make sure to convert it into one of the above. If you send your photo story as email, please make sure not to send files that are larger than 5MB. If you send your photo story as CD or DVD, files can of course be larger. Please also note that your submission does not become binding before you received a confirmation to your email or to your CD/DVD.

For the production of your films / photo stories you may use digital camcorders, usual cameras, or your mobile phone.

You will be able to directly upload your film at a secured area of the website. You will receive an entry code once you signed up for the competition. As soon as your contribution appears on the website www.klimaclima.com / www.klimaclima.org it counts as handed in for the competition and remains to the lead organizer.

It is also possible to send us your internet films and photo stories in form of a CD or DVD and via post. Please make sure not to send printed versions of the photo stores because only in digital format they can be sent to the jury.

Jury and Awards

The competition will have two levels: the first selection will be done within each country separately. Each country will select five internet films and five photo stories. Those ten country winners will then take part at the international competition. The main awards go to the winners of the international competition. There will be awards for each format category.

The decision about the winners is taken by the jury members. According to the two levels of the competition there will be a jury for each country. Additionally, each country will nominate one jury member to be part of the international jury.

The main awards per format category for the international competition are:

1. Scholarship for the International Summer University (accommodation included) in Chile or in Germany
2. 200 EUR
3. 100 EUR

The winners will be announced in March 2010 on the website www.klimaclima.org. The winners will be notified by the organisers.

The awards ceremony will take place in late March in Riga, Latvia.



Liability

The organizer of the competition will not take any responsibility for the loss or incompleteness of the contributed work pieces. This will only be the case if the loss or incompleteness of any competition material goes back to the negligent conduct of the organizer. This also includes the publishing through a third person out of technical mistakes during the transfer of data.

Copyright and Personal Rights

The participants grant the organiser simple rights of use for all known and unknown types of use to the contribution submitted by them for the purpose of participation in the competition, such rights being unlimited in terms of geographical location and time and being restricted in terms of content to the competition. This includes the right of duplication and distribution of the contribution on electronic/digital data media – including interactive media – and specifically DVD, CD, CD-ROM, video and the right of providing public access on the Internet and the right of projection. The rights of use are granted free of charge. The organiser shall be entitled to grant the aforementioned rights to third parties.

The participants hereby give an assurance that the contribution submitted are free of rights of third parties, e.g. copyright, other ancillary copyright, personal rights, and that the contribution is at their disposal to use it freely. As a precaution they indemnify the organiser for all claims of third parties which are based on the fact that the foregoing assurance does not apply.
